## **Projects for critical infrastructure specialists**

The EUCCD defines the implementation of projects aimed at critical infrastructure specialists as a strategic direction of its activities, focusing on the human dimension of system resilience in crisis and post-crisis conditions. This area covers the development and implementation of comprehensive solutions for professional groups that ensure the continuous functioning of vital sectors, with an emphasis on quality, sustainability and long-term impact.

## **CSO capacity development**

Promoting the development of a capable and sustainable civil society sector through long-term cooperation with civil society organisations focused on institutional strengthening, improving the quality of activities and achieving systemic impact in Ukraine's recovery and development processes.

## **International cooperation**

The development of international cooperation is a strategic direction aimed at integrating Ukrainian humanitarian and development initiatives into a broader European and international context.

The EUCCD participates in joint strategic planning and support for international projects, as well as in the dissemination of international experience in the Ukrainian context, taking into account local needs and long-term development goals.

We adhere to the principles of integrity, preventing misuse of resources and fraud, ensuring transparency and accountability in all initiatives

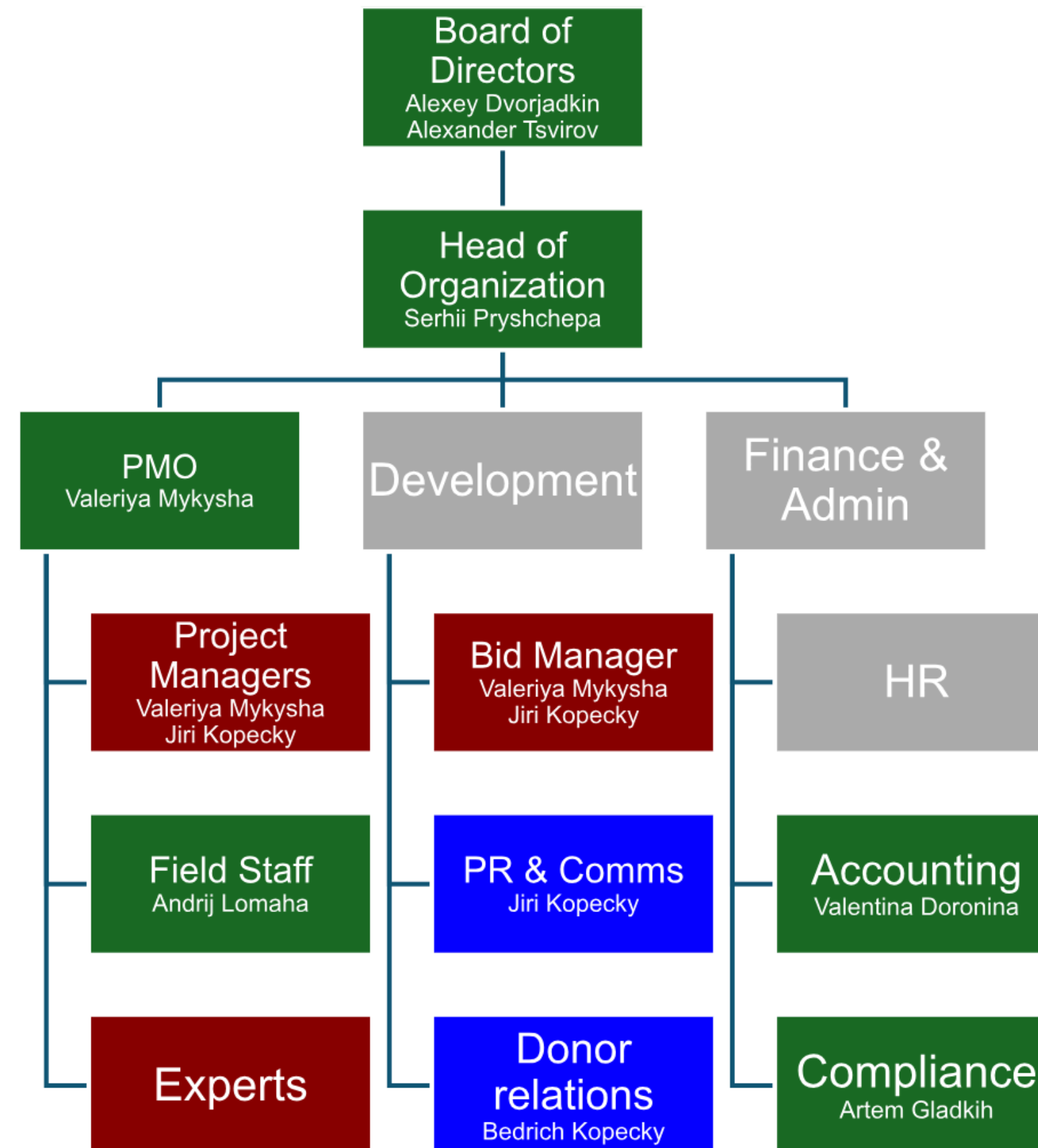
## **Focus on real impact**
